

REGULATIONS OF OPTIONAL/FACULTATIVE CLASSES 2022/2023

on faculties:

full-time and part-time dental medicine and English Dentistry Division

Optional classes should be implemented in the amount of 15 hours or multiples of 15 hours per academic year.

1. Enrollment in optional classes is tantamount to the obligation to complete the course, which is billed in accordance with the Academic Regulations.

- The student has the opportunity to resign from participation in selected optional classes, provided that he/she notifies the resignation no later than two weeks before the start of the class.

2. The name of the optional class should be different from the name of the subject.

3. Optional classes shall be billed on the basis of the number of groups expressed in total, in accordance with the Order No. 197/2020 of the Rector of Medical University of Warsaw dated September 28, 2020.

4. The number of student groups in didactic classes shall be determined in accordance with Order No. 197/2020 of the Rector of Medical University of Warsaw dated September 28, 2020 and Order No. 133/2021 of the Rector of Medical University of Warsaw dated July 2, 2021.

5. In the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, the minimum number of students in a group is 20.

6. In the English Dentistry Division and the medical-dental part-time faculty, only those optional classes will be launched, which the students will select by a majority vote in the year. Optional classes selected by majority vote will be compulsory for the entire year.

7. Groups in English Dentistry Division studies with less than 20 students shall be billed as for one group.

The Regulations shall enter into force as of the date of signature.
